

Substance Abuse

Eliminates all services to more than 55,000 adults including urinalysis and physical exams, ITA, drug courts, inpatient treatment & residential / recovery house services)

Food Assistance

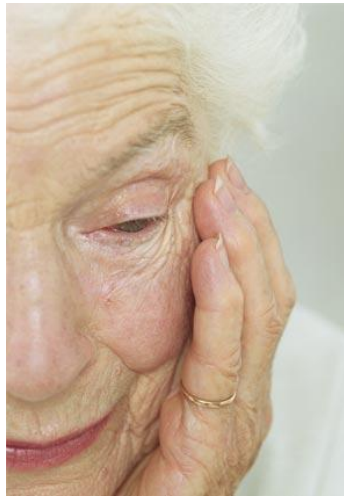
Elimination of State Food Assistance program affecting 13,000 clients
Senior Farmers Market loses State funds

Long term Care

Elimination of services for 11,700 in-home, 1,000 in adult family homes, 2,700 in assisted living, 1,000 in boarding homes, & 450 in nursing homes. Adult Day Health eliminated for 1000 on Medicaid

Healthcare

Termination of Basic Health Plan affecting 35,000 adults
Elimination of Adult Dental affecting 123,000 adults
Elimination of Disability Lifeline for 23,000 adults



Medication

Adult pharmacy benefits will be suspended for 18 months affecting 500,000 clients statewide

Mental Health

Raises the eligibility level for MH services. Elimination of funding for respite, clubhouses, and supported employment
Closing 4 wards at two State Hospitals

Housing

Reduction of Homeless Assistance results in additional 159 homeless in biennium & Reduction of Housing Essential Needs for Disability Lifeline recipients results in additional 1,617 homeless each month
